— Ice Age.

— I like Spirited Away.

Telling the time

What time is the movie?

—It's at seven o'clock.

—It's at half past four.

They will prepare a poster,a cartoon,a dialogue and questions about movies using web 2.0 tools.

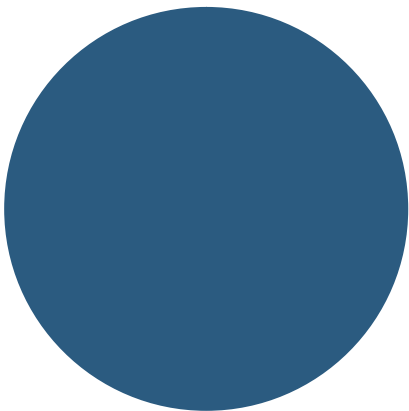

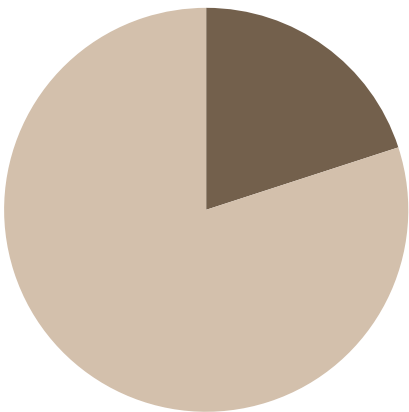
