Students will prepare a poster,a cartoon,a dialogue,a role card and questions using web 2.0 tools.

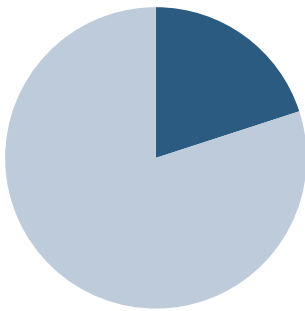

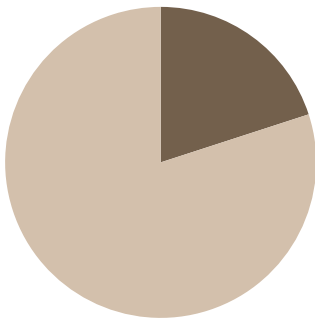
